

Tree of Inspiration - Teacher Nomination Criteria

Who can be nominated?

Any teacher, administrator, specialist or school staff member who has worked in the Glen Cove City Public School District for at least eight years can be nominated. A prospective nominee may be a current or former employee, whether living or deceased.

Who can nominate someone for Tree recognition?

Any student, alumni, teacher, administrator, specialist, staff member, or community member may submit a nominee's name for consideration.

How can someone be nominated?

Send the nominee's name via email to info@famegc.org with the subject line: "Tree of Inspiration Nominee."

Provide the following information:

1. Nominee's name.
2. Why you think the nominee should be recognized on the Tree of Inspiration – please give specific examples or anecdotes.
3. How you know the nominee (e.g., student, colleague, alum, parent of GC students).
4. The best way for FAME GC to contact you for additional information if needed (email and/or phone number).

How will the applications be evaluated and honorees determined?

FAME GC's Board of Directors will evaluate nominees. It reserves the right to conduct meetings and may request additional information about potential nominees. FAME GC will review submissions in an objective and non-discriminatory manner and may seek input from the district on a nominee's suitability and fitness. FAME GC anticipates at least one nominee per year, but this number is subject to change. Nominees from one year may be rolled over for consideration in a subsequent year. FAME GC is an independent entity, and the final selection of a nominee remains in its sole and complete discretion.
